Online Safety Day Tuesday 5th February 2019

This week your child has seen a video and received information about staying safe online. For Key Stage I this looked at, not sharing information or pictures in any online context. The focus was on ensuring an adult is informed about any concerns children have.



For Key Stage 2, children were reminded that social media sites have a starting age of 13, and therefore should be avoided by primary aged children. Children were encouraged not to share any personal information online and made aware of the potential dangers of doing so. Children were also informed of a number of laws that protect pupils from being harassed, victimised or bullied by another child or children online. Time was taken to

explain malicious acts and the possible consequences that could result. Please discuss any online activity with your child and ensure appropriate

privacy settings are used where appropriate. Please also reinforce the responsible use of technology in order to avoid offence being given.
